

Courses are for young people between 16 and 21 years old who...

Have left school and do not have the qualifications to progress onto further education, training or employment.

- CDET B Training allowance of between €40 and €193 may be payable to participants.
- Subsidised Childcare for your child may be available through the Childcare Employment and Training Support (CETS) scheme.



Progression

All learners have access to Career Guidance Support.

During the course learners will develop a progression plan to assist them move onto Further Education, Training or Employment when they complete their time on the programme.
